


Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility

Make the Most of Every Trip!!

Thank you for disposing your household hazardous waste (HHW) safely and responsibly by using the City's HHW Collection Facility.

Even though a fee is not collected when you drop your HHW at the Facility, revenues collected on your trash bill pay for this important local convenience.

Last year over 3,000 vehicles used the Facility at a cost of almost \$200,000. Many Facility users were repeat visitors bringing single items. Since the City is charged per vehicle, no matter if a car brings one gallon of paint or 15 gallons, it saves all of us money if every vehicle brings a full load. You can help make the most of the dollars available in one of these ways:

Full Mixed Load - Bring a FULL mixed load to make the most of the per vehicle charge paid by the City:

- ◆ Includes cleaners, paints, pool chemicals, pesticides, fertilizer, aerosol cans, gasoline and used motor oil.
- ◆ The legal transportation limit is 125 pounds; a typical 125 pound load is equal to 15 gallons of liquids (paint, oil, or gasoline), or a 30-33 gallon trash can full of dry items (pesticides, aerosol cans, fertilizer, etc.).

Single Type Load - Bring a single type HHW load that is FREE OF CHARGE to the City:

- ◆ Electronic Waste ONLY (computer, monitor, TV)
- ◆ Household Batteries ONLY (household alkaline batteries)
- ◆ Sharps ONLY

There is no charge to the City for these single type loads as long as these items are not mixed with charged items described in **1** above.



The City strives to make HHW disposal convenient for residents by having a Collection Facility located at 12325 Crosthwaite Circle open most Saturdays between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. with no appointment necessary.
